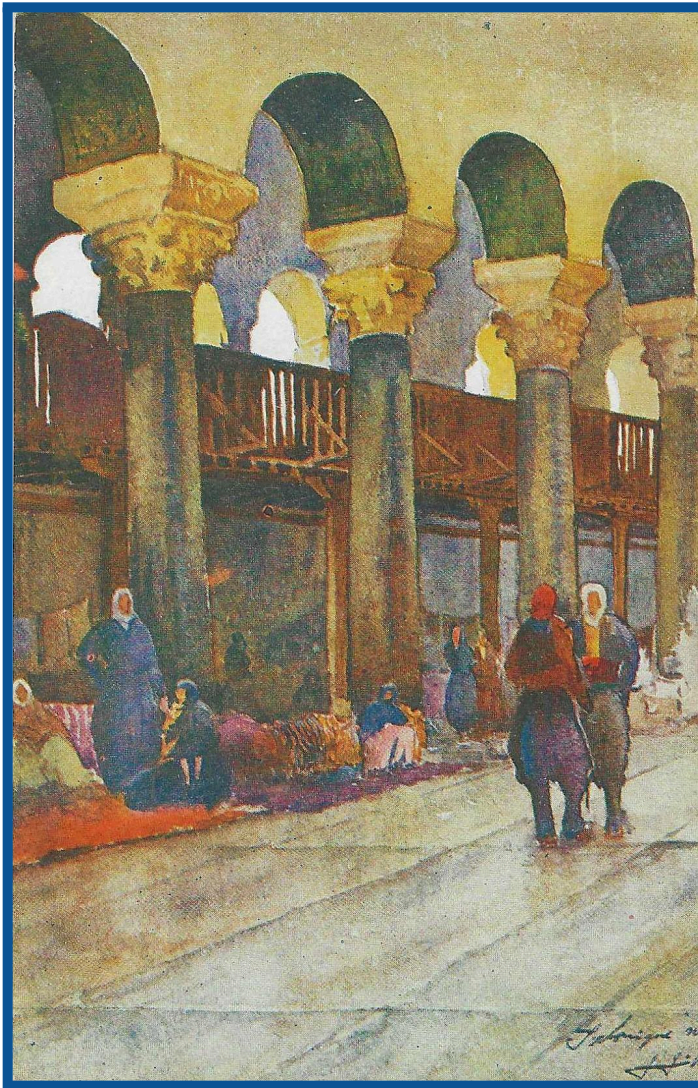


The Alley of the Well

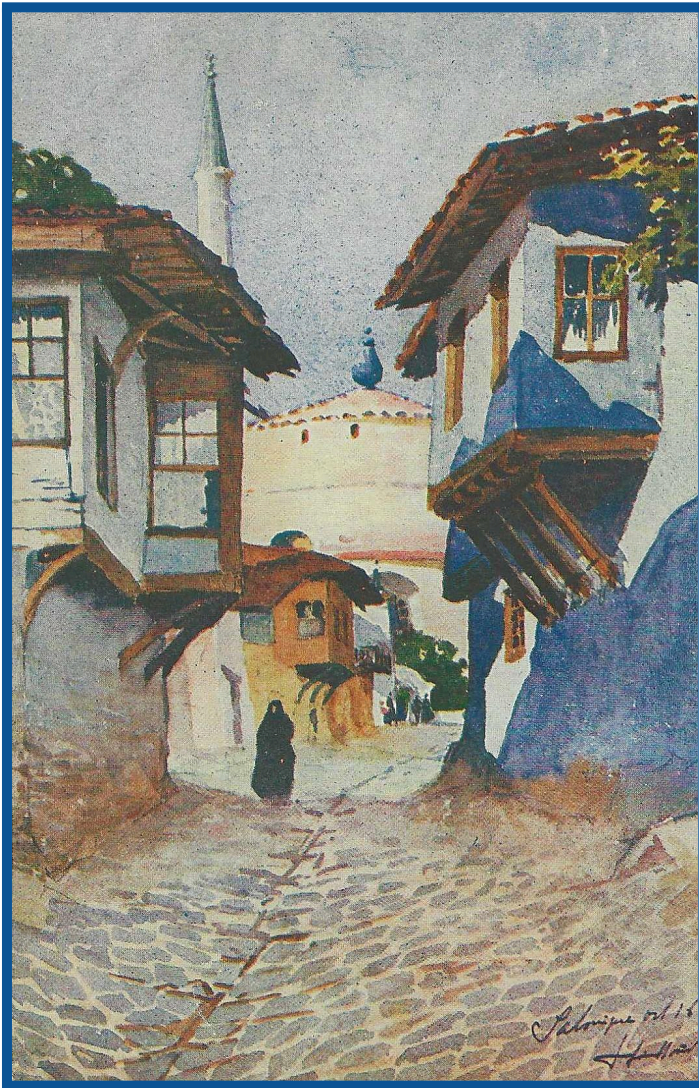

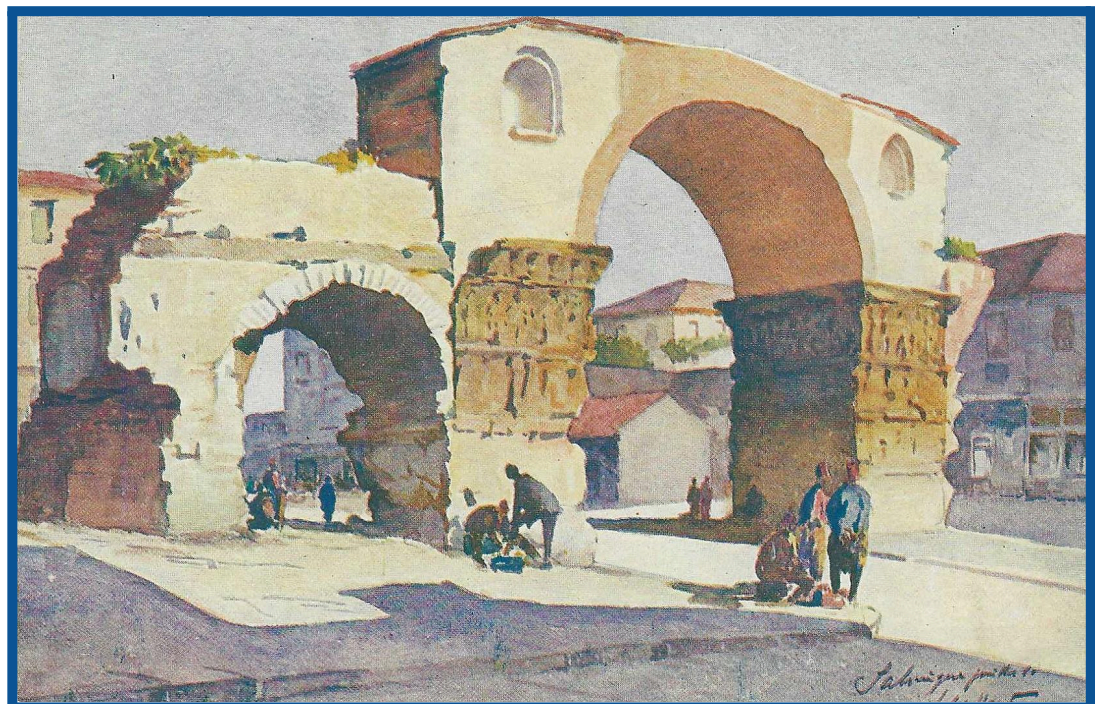

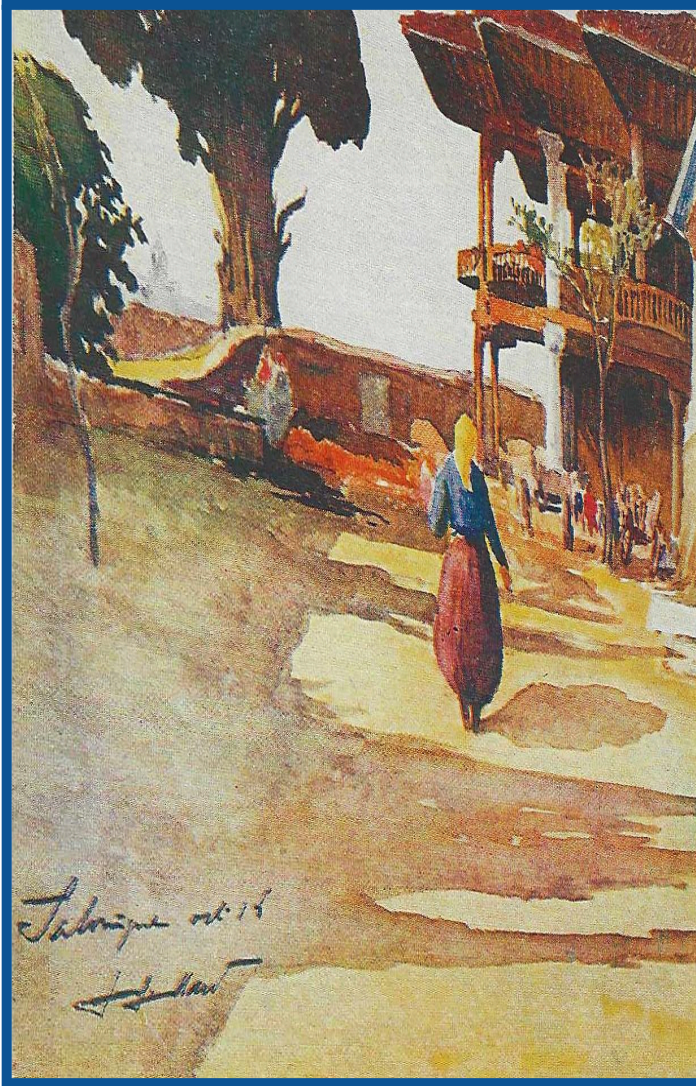


Saint George's church

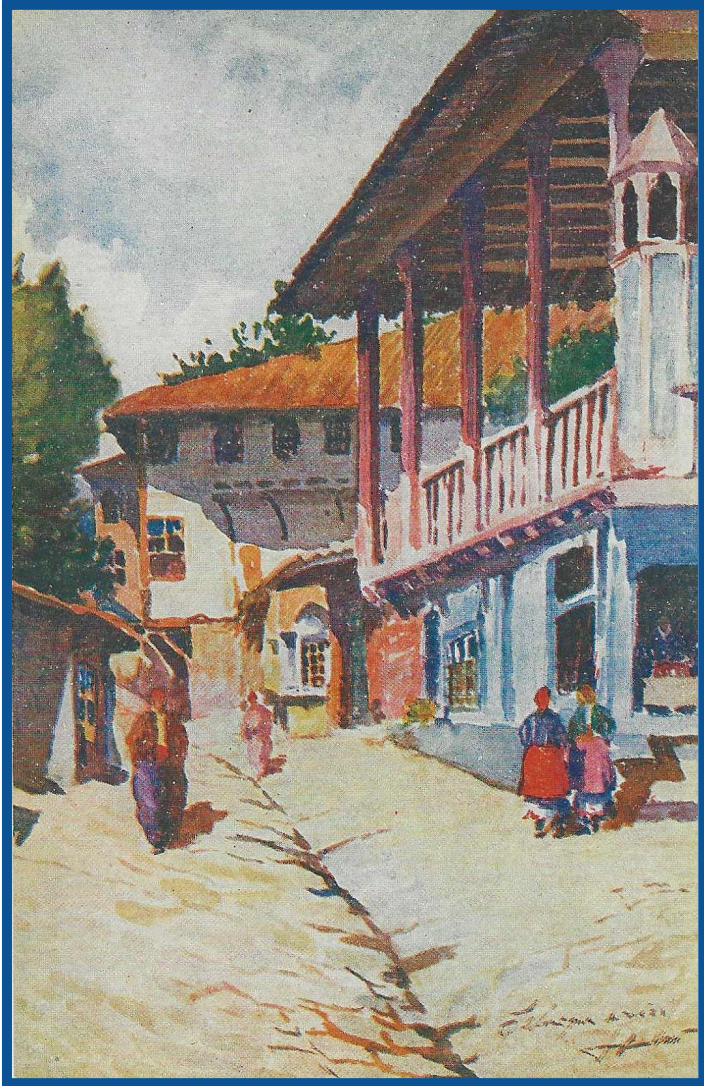


The triumphal Arch of Galere

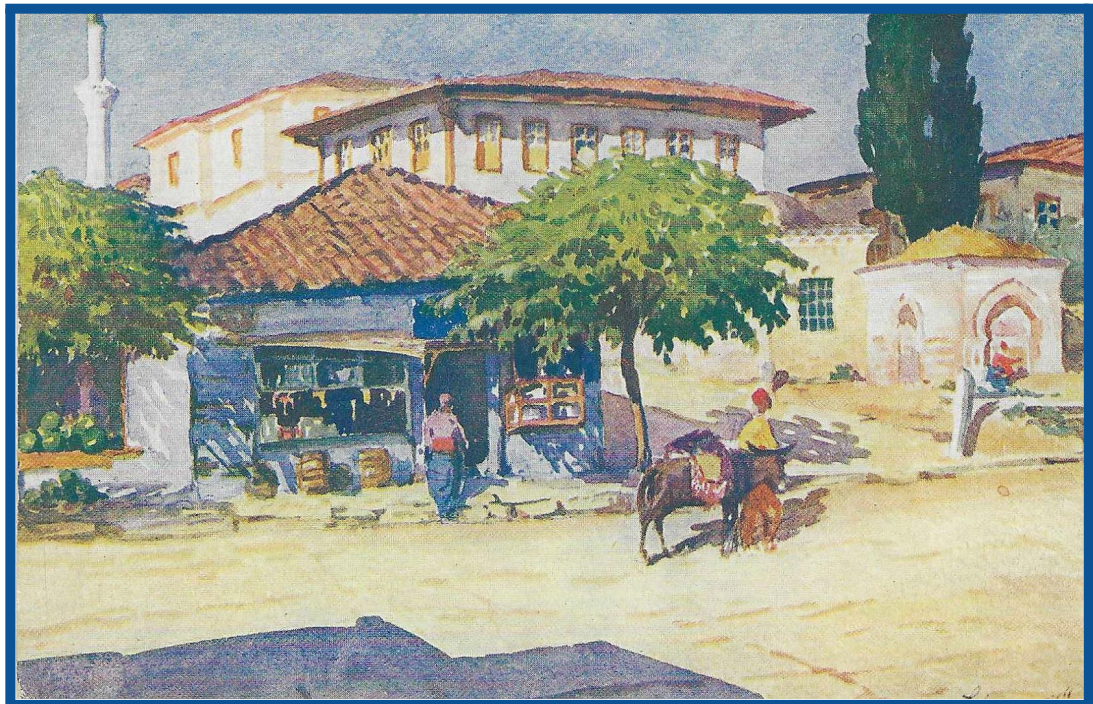

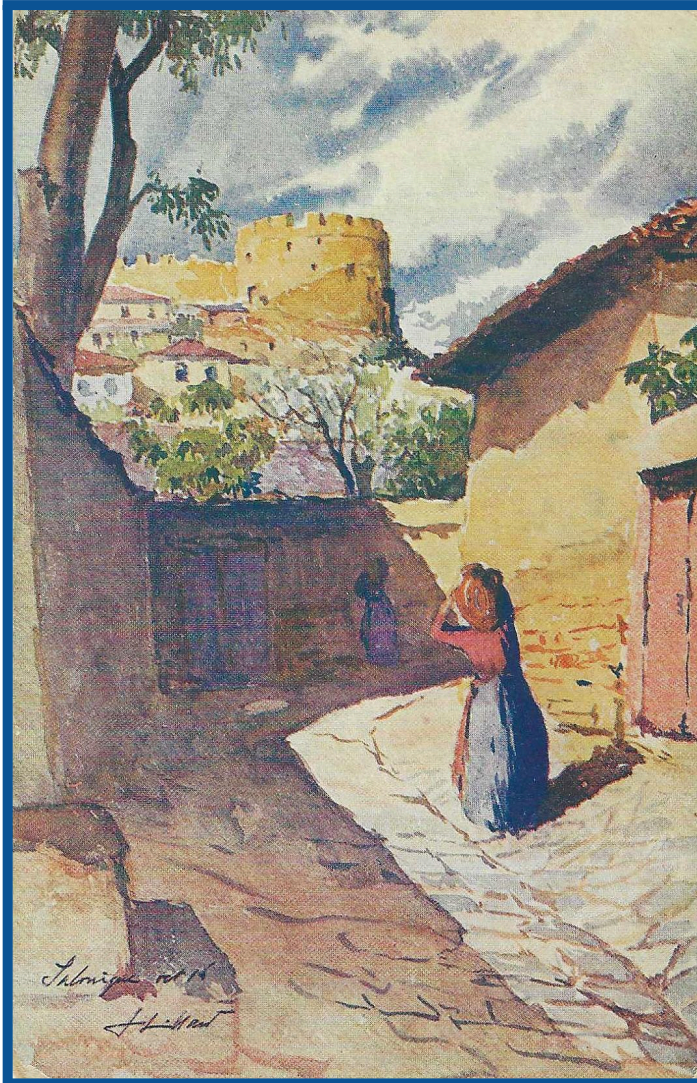


Old Tekke Egnatia Street

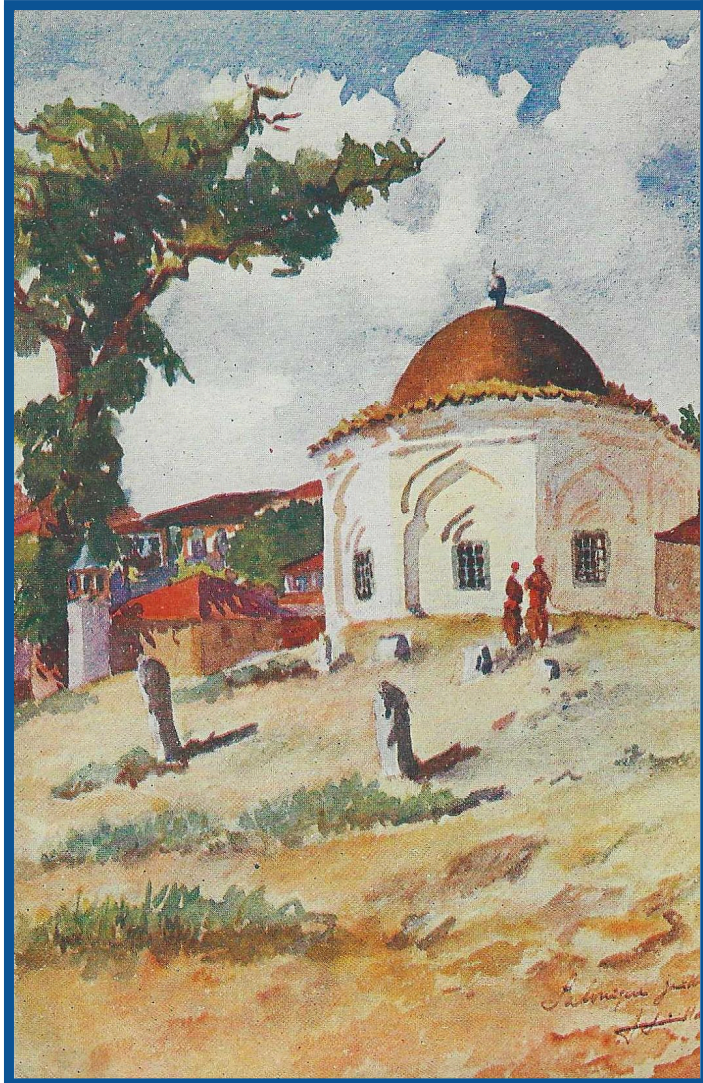

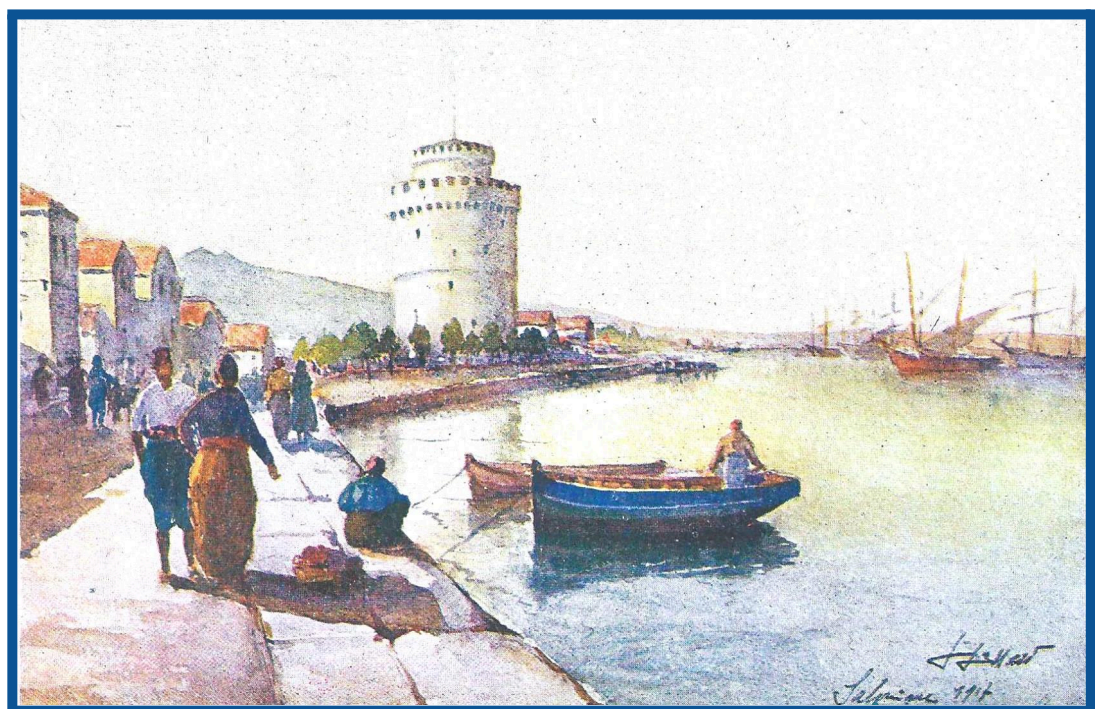
